

RoHS-REACH Declaration of Conformity

Declaration of Conformity – RoHS

We hereby declare that our products comply with the requirements of the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU, as well as the amendment under Directive 2015/863/EU issued by the European Parliament and the Council, which pertains to limiting hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. We affirm that our products meet the specified maximum concentration values in homogeneous materials, which are: less than 0.01% for cadmium and less than 0.1% for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium (Cr6+), polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), and the phthalates DEHP, BBP, DBP, and DIBP as outlined in Annexes III and IV of the Directive.

Additionally, Tronser GmbH confirms that, per the exemption listed in Annex III, Exemption 6(c), the use of lead in copper and brass alloys is permitted up to a concentration of 4% by weight. Furthermore, in accordance with Annex III, Exemption 7(a), the use of lead in high melting temperature type solders, specifically those lead-based alloys containing 85% or more by weight of lead, is also permitted.

Tronser GmbH ensures that all products are either in full compliance with the RoHS standards or are permissible under the specified RoHS exemptions.


Declaration of Conformity – REACH

Tronser GmbH as a producer of electric and electronic goods is classified as a «downstream handler» in the sense of REACH regulation 1907/2006. Duties and liabilities for pre-registration or registration (ECHA) based on the production and bringing into circulation of substances and chemicals are therefore not effective for Tronser GmbH. Our products are manufactured items and therefore not to be defined as substance or preparation. Furthermore, the items manufactured by Tronser GmbH do not evaporate or lay off any substances as long as operated under normal and foreseeable conditions. Consequently, Tronser GmbH is not subject to any registration duty nor the duty to issue safety datasheets. To continuously provide our customers with reliable and safe products, Tronser GmbH ensures that our suppliers comply with all requirements related to the usage of chemical substances and materials. Thus, we ensure that no substances or materials from the list of alarming substances (ECHA SVHC 233 -17/01/2023) are used for the production of our products. <http://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>
